Reading

- Please try to **read** with your child at least **three times each week**. After each reading session, we would really appreciate it if you could write a short comment in your child's reading record so we know they have been reading at home.
- Your child will also bring home a '**Book to Share**' for you to enjoy together. This is a book they have chosen themselves, so it may not match their current phonics level. Giving children the opportunity to choose books that interest them helps to develop a lifelong love of reading. These books will be **changed once a week**.

Choose at least 1 of the following activities to complete each week.

 Get Collecting!

Go on an **Autumn walk** together and collect some natural treasures, such as colourful leaves, conkers, pine cones or twigs. Talk about what you have found, where you found it and how it feels, smells or looks. Which is your favourite autumn treasure?

🎵 Get playing and singing! Practise these games and songs linked to our topic. Head, shoulders, knees and toes.

Complete your Toothbrushing Chart.

(Be sure your child uses a pea-sized amount of toothpaste and brushes for two minutes.)

Get Writing!

Use your **name card** to practise writing your name.
First, trace over each letter with your finger.
Then, have a go at writing your name in your Homework Book. Remember to start each letter in the correct place and take your time – practice makes progress!



Get Drawing! Draw and label a picture of your family.



Go on a **number hunt** around your home! How many different numbers can you find? Look for numbers on clocks, doors, books, food packets, remote controls and more.



Practise putting on your coat and doing up the zip independently. Remember, it's okay if it takes a few tries—you'll get better each time!



We have been learning our six Gospel Values: Forgiveness, Honesty, Hope, Kindness, Love and Respect. Choose one of our values and create a piece of art to symbolise it, for example you may wish to paint or collage a love heart for 'Love' or draw a picture of you with your St Richard's friends for 'Kindness'. These will be displayed in our classroom next to our 'Values' wall.
